PANEL'S COMMENTS

- Unabashed
 - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have an injury to its offside knee.
 - A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required prior to Unabashed racing again.
 - Trainer Steven Pateman advised Unabashed has now been retired from racing.

- Sir Walter Scott
 - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be slightly lame in the offside foreleg
 - A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required prior to Sir Walter Scott racing again.
 - Sir Walter Scott is required to trial over a distance of at least 2400m prior to accepting in future jumps races.

- The Bunsta
 - A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.
 - The Bunsta is required to complete a trial over 2800m to the satisfaction of the JRP prior to accepting in future jumps races. Must be competitive in this trial.
- Mutineer
 - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg.
 - A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required prior to Mutineer racing again.
 - No action has been taken against Mutineer and future jumps performances will be monitored.
