- Lord of The Song
  - Sustained abrasions and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

- The Panel reviewed the incident and have liaised with Warrnambool Racing Club and recommended the following be prior to the next jumps meeting:
  - Moveable rail be inserted in-between the Tozer Road Double obstacles.
  - The drain area to be filled in subject to local planning authority approvals which is acknowledged may take some time.
  - White sighter to be applied to the brush next to the second obstacle.
- Saddle the Stars
  - No action has been taken against Saddle the Stars.
- Al Shahn
  - No action has been taken against Al Shahn.
- Slowpoke Rodriguez
  - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had sustained a laceration to its off foreleg.
  - No action has been taken against Slowpoke Rodriguez.
