COMMENTS:

HACHIOR –

- Made faulty jump at the third obstacle and fell.
- A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.
- Rider R O’Sullivan stated he was instructed to not fight his mount as the gelding does have a tendency to over race.
- Rider R O’Sullivan explained the gelding simply took an extra step when approaching the third obstacle.
- JRP Reviewed the incident - no action taken.
- Gelding requires satisfactory 2800m trial prior to starting again.

MR. COYNE -

- Approaching the third obstacle, Gelding shied at the fallen Hachoir, shifted in abruptly and dislodged rider L Horner
- A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore.
- JRP Reviewed the Geldings performance - no action taken.
