### PANEL'S COMMENTS

- A post race veterinary examination revealed Arribos to be lame in the left hind and will need a veterinary certificate before next start.
- Trainer Jim Conlan has been advised Arribos must trial to the satisfaction of the Jumps Review Panel prior to accepting in future jumps races.
- A post race veterinary examination of Longshaw revealed no obvious abnormalities.
- The Panel noted Longshaw was hampered by the fallen Arribos and was jumping satisfactorily prior to this. No action has been taken however future jumps performances will be monitored. Rider Clayton Douglas has been referred to coach Craig Durden.
- A veterinary examination of Sir Bigglesworth revealed the horse had sustained a racing injury. The horse received first aid on course and was transported for further assessment and treatment.
- The Waterhouse stable was notified that a Veterinary Clearance must be presented before the horse is accepted to race again. The stable further advised the Jumps Review Panel Sir Bigglesworth has been retired from racing and re-homed.
- A post race veterinary examination of Camon Houdini revealed no obvious abnormalities.
- The Waterhouse stable was advised that Camon Houdini is required to trial satisfactorily prior to accepting in future jumps races.
- The Waterhouse stable also advised Sesentum has been retired from jumps racing.

**PANEL'S COMMENTS**

- A post race veterinary examination of Rabukka revealed a laceration to it's off fore leg.
- No action has been taken against Rabukka but its future performances in jumps races will be monitored.
- A post race veterinary examination of Sanctuary revealed an abrasion to its right fore.
- Trainer Anthony Cosgriff advised the Panel he intends to focus on hurdle races with Sanctuary and he was advised the horse must trial in a steeplechase trial prior to accepting in future steeplechase races.
- A post race veterinary examination of Swney's Banjo revealed a laceration to the right front limb.
- Due to Swney's Banjo's satisfactory jumps record no action has been taken and future jumps performances will be monitored.
