- All horses competing in Races 1 and 6 underwent veterinary examinations after arriving on course and were passed suitable to race.
- **Lordoftheparrots**
 - A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.
 - Connections advised the Panel Lordoftheparrots has been retired from racing and will begin a career in eventing.
- **Banksters Bonus**
 - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again. A swab sample was also taken for analysis.
 - The stable has since advised Banksters Bonus has a muscle tear and is being spelled at Angaston SA.
