PURPOSE OF THIS FORM

This form will enable Racing Victoria to make an assessment as to whether they will issue you a Club Bookmaker's Licence.

In Victoria operating as a lawful bookmaker requires a two-step process:

1. BOOKMAKER REGISTRATION AND GUARANTEE

A person must apply to the Victorian Gambling and Casino Control Commission (VGCCC) to become "registered" as a bookmaker.*

As part of that registration process, the person must have a **guarantee** which meets the requirements of section 94A of the *Racing Act 1958* (Vic).

This can be accomplished in two ways: (1) become a member of the Victorian Bookmakers' Association and contribute to their guarantee fund; or (2) make alternative arrangements with the VGCCC.



2. BOOKMAKER LICENCE

A registered bookmaker can then apply to Racing Victoria, as a principal racing authority, to enable them to lawfully commence bookmaking operations. Racing Victoria will not accept any application unless and until you have been registered as a bookmaker by the VGCCC.

For the purposes of this application for a Club Bookmaker's Licence:

"Approved Substitute" means a Registered Bookmaker's Key Employee who has been approved by Racing Victoria pursuant to section 91AB of the Racing Act and Licence Rule 9 to carry on the business of a bookmaker during a period of absence by the Bookmaker.

"Bookmaker Rules" means the *Club Bookmakers' Licence Rules, Bookmakers' Levy Rules 2012, Bookmakers' Telephone Betting Rules 2001* and *Bookmakers' Internet Betting Rules 2001* as published on the <u>RV website</u>,

"Key Employee" means the holder of a current certificate of registration as a Registered Bookmaker's Key Employee under Part 5A of Chapter 4 of the Gambling Regulation Act.

"Metropolitan" racing venue means a race meeting conducted at Flemington, Caulfield, Sandown or Moonee Valley, or select meetings at Mornington and Bendigo.

"Rules of Racing" means the Racing Victoria Rules of Racing (including the Rules of Race Betting) as published on the RV website,

"Terms and Conditions" means the terms and conditions and betting rules which apply to an account, as agreed between the Bookmaker and a client, and as described in Rule 16.7 of the *Club Bookmaker's Licence Rules*.

"Associate" means—

- (a) a person who holds or will hold any Relevant Financial Interest, or is or will be entitled to exercise any Relevant Power (whether in right of the person or on behalf of any other person) in the Applicant's business, and by virtue of that interest or power, is able or will be able to exercise a significant influence over or with respect to the management or operation of that business; or
- (b) a person who is or will be an Executive Officer, whether in right of the person or on behalf of any other person, of the Applicant's business; or
- (c) if the Applicant is a natural person, a person who is a Relative of the Applicant.

Where:

"Executive Officer", in relation to an incorporated entity, means—

- (a) a director, secretary or other officer (by whatever name called); or
- (b) any other person who is concerned with, or takes part in, the management of the entity, whether or not the person's position is given the name of executive officer;

"Relative", in relation to a person, means—

- (a) the spouse or domestic partner of the person;
- (b) the mother or father of the person; or
- (c) a son or daughter (including adopted children) of that person who has attained the age of 18 years;

"Relevant Financial Interest", in relation to the Applicant, means—

- (a) any share in the capital of the Applicant; or
- (b) any entitlement to receive any income derived from the Applicant's business; or
- (c) any entitlement to receive any payment as a result of money advanced; and

"Relevant Power" means any power, whether exercisable by voting or otherwise and whether exercisable alone or in association with others—

- (a) to participate in any directorial, managerial, or executive decision; or
- (b) to elect or appoint any person as an executive officer.

Please also note that meeting the minimum 33% requirement will not guarantee a stand during the next licence period.

Stand allocations will be based on your selections on this Application and allocations will be made in accordance with <u>Racing Victoria's Victorian Bookmakers' Policies</u>. Tick each venue you wish to be considered for - <u>please be careful to complete your selections correctly.</u>

Please note that if you tick a box in any of the tables below, please also tick the corresponding Licence Class in <u>SECTION 1: APPLICATION TYPE</u>. For example, if you tick Rails at Caulfield, Paddock at Sandown and Country racecourses please also tick Class R, Class P and Class C in <u>SECTION 1</u>.
